Follow a relational and restorative approach. All children feel safe and have strong relationships with staff and pupils.

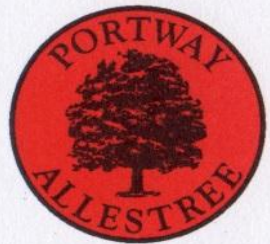
We are an inclusive school where all children thrive to be the best they can be.

Preparing children to thrive in their next part of life and function in society as well rounded humans.





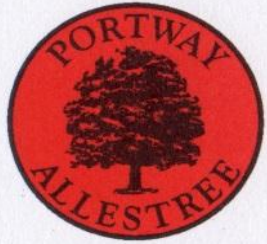
Importance of parental engagement

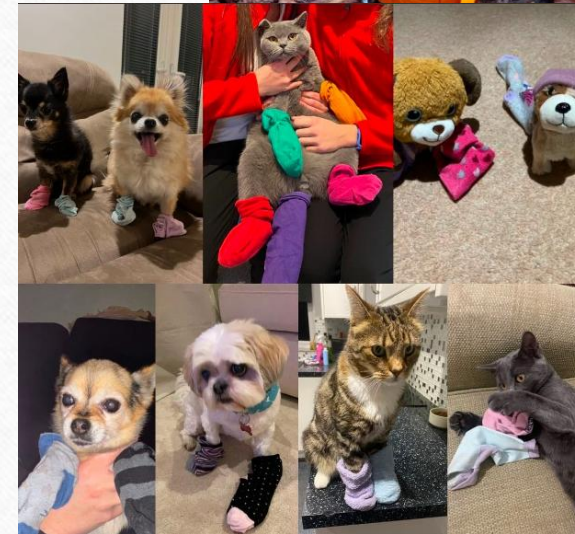


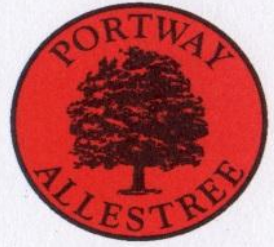


Importance of parental engagement (continued!!)

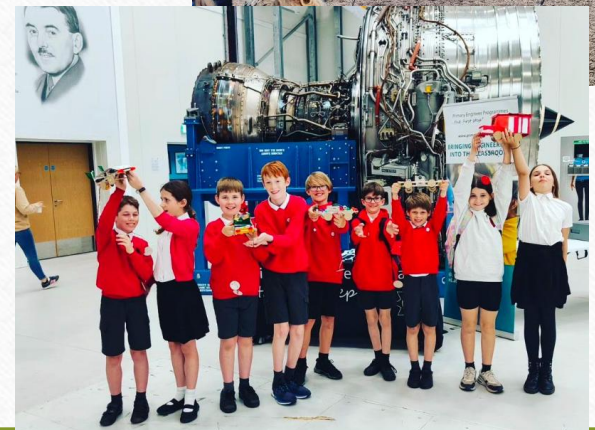


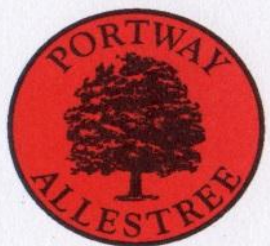


Curriculum: 'learning is memorable, inspirational and engaging for all'

- Residential trips in Year 4 and 6



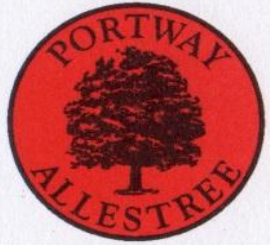

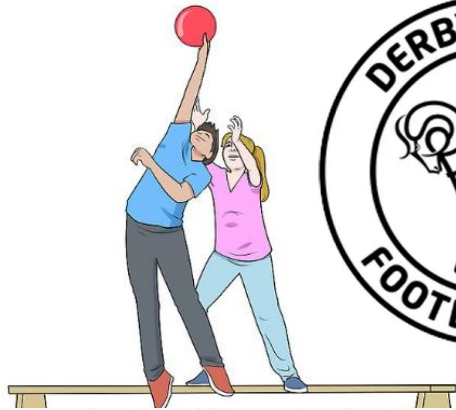


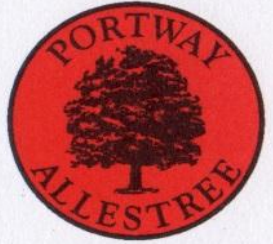

OPAL School

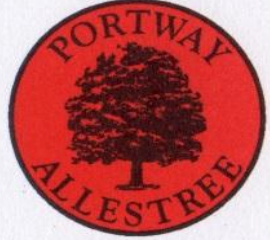
What is Opal Play?

- Fosters a connection with nature.



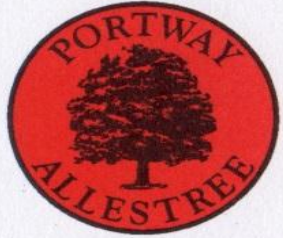

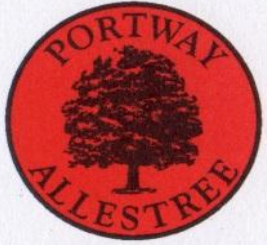
