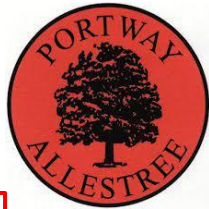

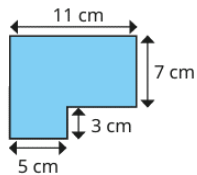

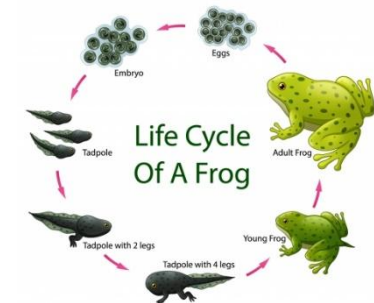


Write a persuasive letter about Camp Green Lake, inspired by the book *Holes*.

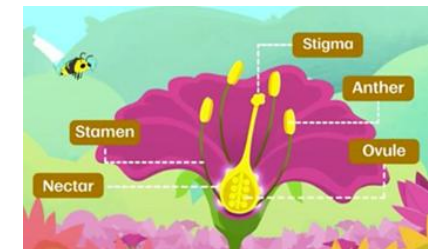
Write a balanced argument about school uniform

Describe reproduction in some plants and animals.

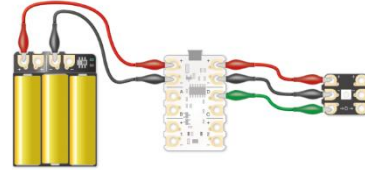
Art & Design

Explore religious architecture using charcoal and more complex shapes.



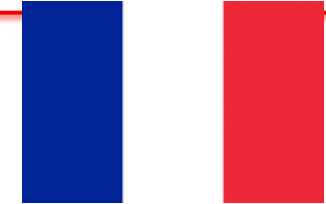
Computing
