

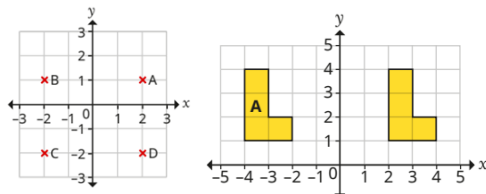
Year 6 Curriculum – Summer 1

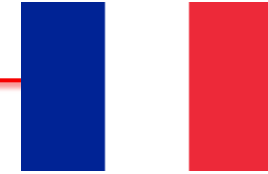

Explore the concept of variables in programming through games in Scratch.



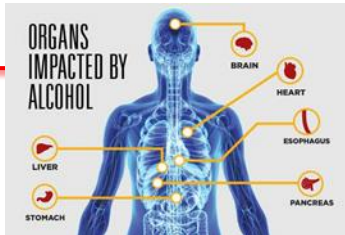
