

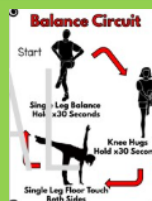
Year 6 Homework Challenge

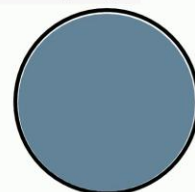
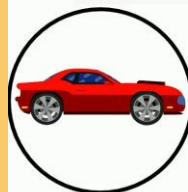


At the start of this term, we took part in the Royal Mint Museum's 500 word story competition. Use their website to explore some of the famous objects they have created including: crowns, coins and medals.
