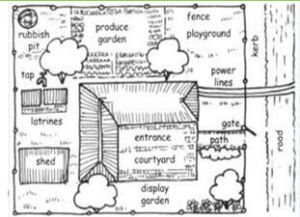


Year 4 Homework Challenge

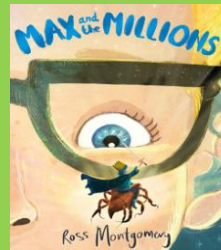
Pick one or more of these challenges to complete and hand in by Monday 20th July.

In RE we have been thinking about journeys. Can you describe/draw/paint/create something that represents a journey that you have been on.

In Geography we have been looking at sketch maps. Can you create a birds eye view map of your house and street?



In Whole Class Reading we are reading the book Max and the Millions. Can you create a blurb for the book. (Summarise what you know so far.) How will you persuade people to read it?

Steps
