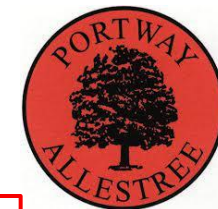


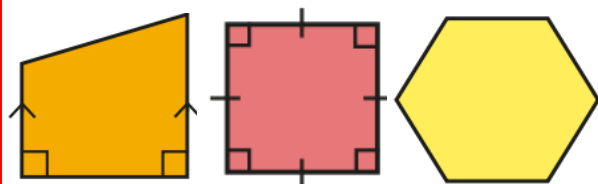
Year 4 Curriculum – Summer 2

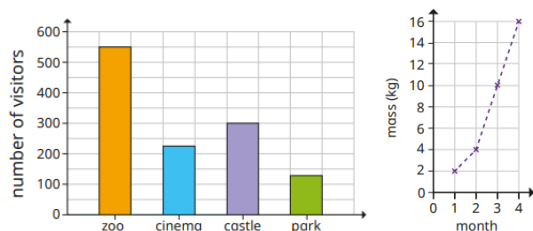
Maths

English



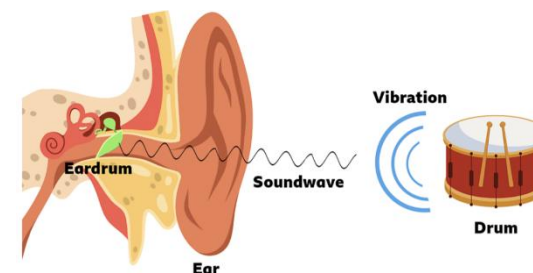
Write a newspaper report using historical facts about Henry VIII.

Explore patterns in nature and sculpture using clay.



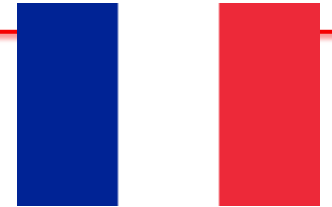
Computing

Digital lives- looking at healthy relationships and keeping safe online.



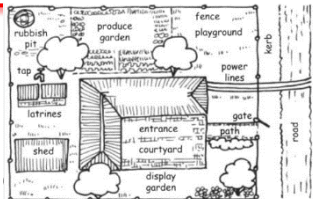
Physical Education
