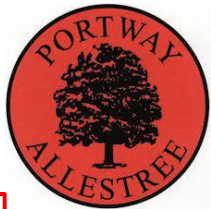


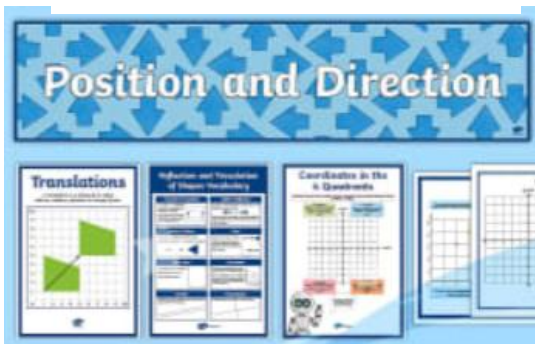
Year 5 Curriculum – Summer 2

English

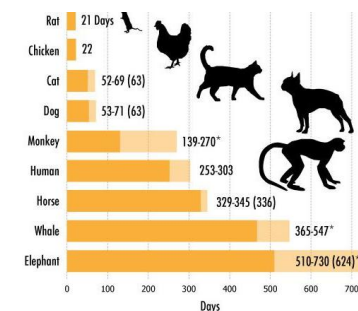


Research and write a factual and informative non-fiction text about the plague.

Research gestation periods of other animals & compare them with humans.

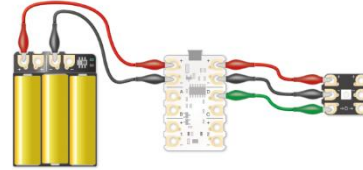
Art & Design

Explore religious architecture using charcoal and more complex shapes.



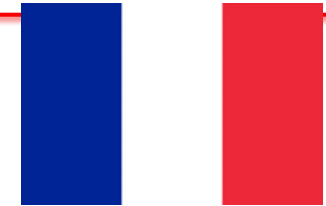
Computing

Explore the concept of selection in programming through the use of micro:bit.



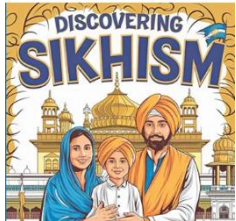
French
